#### ABOUT WHEATON ...

The city of Wheaton was planned by its Founding Fathers to be a charming small town when established in 1837, by Jesse and Warren Wheaton and Erastus Gary. That is how it still stands today, with much attention paid to keeping the quaint tree-lined avenues, Victorian architecture, paved streets, winding sidewalks, and old-town charm.

Comprising the heart of downtown Wheaton is a bustling business district with numerous restaurants, boutiques, and churches. The city also includes booming commercial areas to the north and south including Danada Square East and West, Wheaton Town Square, and Rice Lake Square shopping plazas. The nearest shopping mall,

Stratford Square, is located 5 miles north of the downtown area, on Gary Avenue.

Wheaton has long been considered an ideal place to raise a family, and this reputation is upheld by the city's excellent public school system, which is ranked among the best on all levels in the state of Illinois. Its comprehensive, activity-driven park system and newly renovated and expanded, state-of-the-art public library offer something for residents of every age.

Located 30 miles west of Chicago, Wheaton is nestled amongst Illinois Routes 64 (North Avenue), 38 (Roosevelt Road), and 56 (Butterfield Road). Interstates 88 and 355 all run near the city, providing residents and businesses direct access to virtually any destination in the greater Chicagoland area. Midway and O'Hare Airports are both just 45 minutes away, while downtown Chicago (the Loop) is just 30 minutes away. Metra operates two commuterrail stations in Wheaton, transporting more than 3,200 commuters every day on the Union Pacific West Line. Pace operates several bus routes through town.
